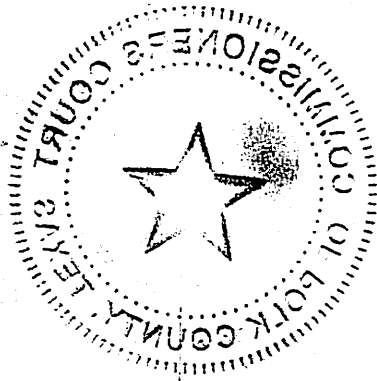
REPORT OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE LAND OFFICE
